- **Genesis**
- **1. Beginnings**
- **2. Examples – creation, man, marriage, sin, death, redemption, grace**

Meaning or emphasis of the first five books of the Bible

- Exodus
- 1. The way out, deliverance
- 2. Key events – Moses, the plagues, the Passover, the crossing of the Red Sea, the Ten Commandments, the tabernacle

Meaning or emphasis of the first five books of the Bible

- Leviticus
- 1. About the Levites, the priests
- 2. Key teachings – worship, the sacrifices, the priests

Meaning or emphasis of the first five books of the Bible

- Numbers
- 1. The people are numbered for war, battle
- 2. Key events – complaining, the 12 spies, wandering for 40 years in the wilderness

Meaning or emphasis of the first five books of the Bible

- Deuteronomy
- 1. Second law
- 2. Why? – the old generation died without teaching their children; Israel is ready to enter the land
