4. What was under the ban? What would cause someone to take something under the ban? What would happen if someone did take something under the ban? What was to be done with all the metal in the city of Jericho? (Joshua 6:15 – 21)

5. What happened to the city of Jericho? What happened to the living things inside of Jericho? What happened to the materials that were in Jericho? What happened to Rahab? (Joshua 6:22 – 25)

6. What curse was put upon anyone who would rebuild Jericho? (Joshua 6:26 – 27)

7. What did the sons of Israel do after they destroyed Jericho? What was the Lord's response? (Joshua 7:1 – 2)

8. What was the 2nd city Israel was supposed to capture? What did Joshua do before he went to battle against the city? What was the suggestion concerning the city? What happened in the battle? What was the result on the people? (Joshua 7:3 – 5)

9. What was Joshua's reaction to what happened? What complaint did Joshua say to the Lord? What does this sound like? What was Joshua's concern? (Joshua 7:6 – 9)

10. What did the Lord told Joshua to do? What did the Lord say was the problem? What did the Lord say was the result of the problem? What did the Lord say was the solution to the problem? (Joshua 7:10 – 15)

11. Who was found to be the transgressor of the ban? What was he told to do? What did he do? How was his transgression progressive? (Joshua 7:16 – 21)

12. What was done with Achan? Who else suffered along with Achan? Why? (Joshua 7:22 – 26)
