 Imputed righteousness is the righteousness God gives to the one who has faith (the faith that God gives him as well) in order that the one who has faith may approach and stand before a holy and righteous God on the basis of Christ's work on behalf of His people on the cross.

 2. Imparted righteousness is accomplished by the Holy Spirit indwelling the believer and assuring the sanctification and eventual glorification of the believer. God first makes a believer positionally righteous and then continues His work in making the believer experiencially righteous. All is the work of God, based on the work of Christ, and is a package deal with the end result of glorification.
