- 12. Why did God have regard for Abel and his offering while having no regard for Cain and his offering? Consider Hebrews 11:4.
- 13. What firsts are seen in Genesis 4?
- 14. What is repeated in Genesis 5? What was the exception?
- 15. What characterized man in Genesis 6? What was God's response?
- 16. Who was different from all others in Genesis 6? What characterized him? What was he called upon by the Lord to do?
