



- The original problem –

 - Main idea each day –
 - separation

The days of creation

- Day 1
 - Separation of light from darkness
- Day 2
 - Separation of the waters
- Day 3
 - Separation of land and sea, vegetation

The days of creation

- The solution to the problem
- Last three days solve the problem of
- Being void
- Main idea each day –
- Fill, multiply

The days of creation

- Day 4
- Filling of the heavens with lights – sun, moon, stars
- Day 5
- Filling of the waters above and below – birds, fish
- Day 6
- Filling of the land – land animals, man

The meaning of day

- Exodus 20:8-11 –
- a literal day, related to creation
- 2 Peter 3:3-11
- 1000 years, 1000 years back to a day, no relationship to creation
- Genesis 1:14, 16, 18
- 12 hour period of light
- Genesis 2:4; 5:5; 7:4-17; 19:38
- Period of time, years, literal day, now
