

# Israel's Current Conflict & God's Eternal Plan

"I am for peace, but when I speak, they are for war!" (Psalm 120:7) On October 7, Hamas launched a surprise attack against Israel by land, sea, and air—infiltrating and overtaking towns and villages near the Gaza border and brutally murdering innocent civilians. More Jewish lives were lost on this day than on any other day since the Holocaust. As Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu announced, "Citizens of Israel, we are at war. Not an operation [a round of fighting], at war!"

## What about the Arabs? (see Rafat Amari, Islam in Light of History)

# 4. Who is Hamas? Why are they terrorists?

- A. Founded in 1987 as the Islamic Resistance Movement
- B. The Muslim Brotherhood in Palestine
- C. A 2018 attempt to condemn Hamas for "acts of terror" at the United Nations failed
- D. On October 7, 2023, Hamas launched "Operation Al-Aqsa Flood" and its fighters broke through the Gaza barrier, attacked Israeli military bases and homes, massacred civilians, and took over 200 hostages back to Gaza

#### Read the Hamas Charter!

The most relevant of the document's 36 articles can be summarized as falling within four main themes:

- 1. Complete destruction of Israel for the liberation of Palestine and the establishment of a theocratic state based on Sharia law,
- 2. Unrestrained and unceasing holy war (jihad) to attain the above objective,
- 3. Deliberate disdain for, and dismissal of, any negotiated resolution or political settlement of claims to the Holy Land, and
- Reinforcement of anti-Semitic tropes and conspiracy theories.
