Olivet Discourse Outline #6 – Matt. 24:29-31

Context: Having moved in our study through the Tribulation, we come to the focal point of all history. The promised coming of Christ to set things right. It brings to fulfillment all the history of mankind, and particularly man’s history of sin and rebellion against God is brought to a sudden climax. The event is what is ultimately promised immediately following the Garden sin. It is not only promised but alluded to progressively throughout Scripture. It is therefore the most glorious and greatest event beyond the scope of imagination. Jesus Christ will come as He said to judge mankind and to establish His promised kingdom where He will rule and demonstrate for 1000 years the marvel of living righteously on the earth.
