A Comparison of Arminianism with Calvinism - Point Five

Arminianism	Calvinism
Falling from Grace Those who believe and are truly saved can lose their salvation by failing to maintain their faith. Not all who are Arminian agree on this point; some hold that all who have once believed are eternally secure in Christ or that once a sinner is regenerated, he can never be lost.	Perseverance of the Saints All who are chosen by God, redeemed by Christ, and given faith by the Spirit are and will be eternally saved. They are kept in their faith by the power of Almighty God and thus will not only maintain their faith but persevere through whatever trials or difficulties come in this life to this life's end.
