## **Discussion Questions:**

#### 1. What does it mean to be made in the image of God?

- a. How do the spiritual, relational, and functional aspects of God's image shape our identity and purpose?
- b. How should this truth affect the way we view ourselves and others?

### 2. How has sin distorted God's image in humanity?

- a. What were the immediate consequences of Adam and Eve's sin in Genesis 3?
- b. How do we still see these consequences in the world today?

#### 3. Why is it important to understand both our inherited sin nature and our personal sin?

- a. Read Rom 5:12-19 and Rom 3:11. What do these passages reveal about our inability to seek God on our own?
- b. How does this truth shape our understanding of salvation?

### 4. What is the significance of Jesus being called "the Last Adam"?

- a. How does Christ undo what Adam did (compare Rom 5:18-19 and 1 Cor 15:22)?
- b. What does this tell us about our need for redemption in Him?

#### 5. In which man are you found—Adam or Christ?

a. The message emphasized that we are either in Adam (condemned) or in Christ (redeemed). Which one describes you?
