Proverbs 31:10 – *An excellent wife, who can find? For her worth is far above jewels.*

2 Timothy 3:15 – *“And that from childhood you have known the sacred Scripture which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Jesus Christ.”*

- **The Selfless Woman (2 Tim. 3:15):**

“I remember my mother's prayers and they have always followed me. They have clung to me all my life” Abraham Lincoln.

2 Tim. 1:5 – “For I am mindful of the sincere faith within you, which first dwelt on your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am sure that it is in you as well.”

• **The Spiritual Woman (2 Tim. 1:5):**

Issues on influencing my children:

- You cannot impart what you do not possess and then exemplify it. If your children seldom see you seeking God through His Word and prayer, neither will they for themselves – it must be top priority.
- You must make prayer with and for your children a matter they see, hear, and know is occurring?
- If they don’t see you changing in your growing understanding of and obedience to the Word, they won’t be motivated to think the Word is important to you, and it won’t be to them.
- If the Bible is seldom read to the children, not quoted to them appropriately as they move through situations and experiences of living, do not expect them to pay attention to it.
- If mom is not concerned about what church, what Sunday School teacher, or pastor is speaking to her children and about what, the children will assume such is not that important.
