Reflection Questions:

1. Where am I tempted to “seek a sign” from God instead of submitting to the truth He’s already made clear in His Word?
2. Am I responding to the light I’ve been given, or am I resisting it, postponing repentance, or negotiating with God on my terms?
3. How does the resurrection of Jesus function as God’s final, sufficient sign in my doubts, fears, or temptations right now?
4. If the Queen of Sheba and the people of Nineveh responded to far less light than I have, what does my response to Christ reveal about my heart?
5. What concrete step of repentance, obedience, or witness is this passage calling me to take this week in light of the greater light I’ve received?

Heart Check:

- If God has already given me His greatest sign in the crucified and risen Christ, what more do I want, and what does my response to Him reveal about the true condition of my heart?
