Reflection Questions:

1. Where am I most tempted to believe the lie that sin will satisfy me more than obedience to God?
2. Am I guarding my heart, eyes, and mind against the subtle pull of sexual impurity, or am I giving temptation room to grow?
3. How am I actively pursuing contentment and joy in God’s design for purity, whether that be through faithfulness in marriage or faithfulness in singleness?
4. When I sin or struggle with temptation, do I run to the Lord for forgiveness and renewal, trusting that His grace truly restores what sin destroys?
5. What does my attitude toward purity and faithfulness reveal about my heart?

Heart Check

- A proud heart flirts with temptation, a deceived heart excuses it, but a humble heart that fears the Lord sees purity not as a burden, but as a blessing – and so it flees from sexual sin and delights in God’s design.
- So which heart describes mine today, and where is God calling me to repent, to trust, and to walk in wisdom?
